workshop requirements



important information

If you do not hold a Level 4 or above qualification in chemical peels you will require a vocationally competent therapist to support you during the workshop. In order to be able to provide valid certification for insurance purposes, a vocationally competent therapist is required to support the Pro Power Peel student during the practical session for safety and to assist the Educator on areas of clarification or where a close-up visual may be required.

The vocationally competent therapist must:

- o be qualified to Level 3 or above
- o be trained and certified in Pro Power Peel
- o hold valid liability insurance for peels
- o be competent to perform an eye flush emergency procedure and manage contra-actions

Treatment models must be:

- o pre-screened and consulted prior to the practical workshop to establish treatment suitability
- o [patch tested](#) a minimum of 72 hours prior to workshop to allow replacement of model subject to adverse skin response
