### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If you do not hold a Level 4 or above qualification in chemical peels you will require a vocationally competent therapist to support you during the workshop. In order to be able to provide valid certification for insurance purposes, a vocationally competent therapist is required to support the Pro Power Peel student during the practical session for safety and to assist the Educator on areas of clarification or where a close-up visual may be required.

The vocationally competent therapist must:

- be qualified to Level 3 or above
- be trained and certified in Pro Power Peel
- hold valid liability insurance for peels
- be competent to perform an eye flush emergency procedure and manage contra-actions

Treatment models must be:

- pre-screened and consulted prior to the practical workshop to establish treatment suitability
- [patch tested](#) a minimum of 72 hours prior to workshop to allow replacement of model subject to adverse skin response

Please be aware any previous manufacturer training such as BioSurface Peel is not equivalent to a Level 4 qualification in chemical peels.
